In the Washington, D.C. region, more than 40,000 young immigrants will be affected by the termination of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA). For the majority of these young people, the United States is the only home they have known. The Administration's policy decision to threaten these young people with deportation and prevent them from obtaining legal employment in the United States harms children and families, undermines our shared values as a nation, and threatens the strength of our communities.

For DACA renewals, Ayuda is offering FREE clinics and designated walk-in dates, as well as preparing renewals by appointment.

If you currently have DACA, and your work permit will expire **on or before March 5, 2018**, please contact Ayuda to register for one of our clinics in Virginia or Washington, D.C.
